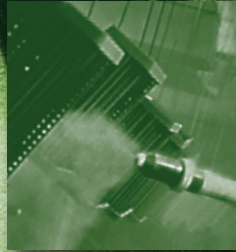




GreenSure™ Product Testing to LEED Certification

To reduce the quantity of indoor air contaminants that are odorous, potentially irritating and/or harmful to the comfort and well-being of occupants, several LEED Rating Systems require emissions testing for finished products.



Testing of finished products is required for the following LEED Rating Systems:

- | LEED COMMERCIAL INTERIORS (LEED CI)
- | LEED FOR SCHOOLS
- | LEED FOR RETAIL

There are several choices for emissions testing procedures. Sherwin-Williams has selected the ANSI/BIFMA (Business and Institutional Furniture Manufacturers Association) Test Method M7.1, that meets the requirements of ANSI/BIFMA Standard X7.1 as verified by an independent laboratory and approved by the USGBC/LEED.

Low-Emitting Materials - Systems Furniture and Seating

REQUIREMENTS:

All systems furniture and seating introduced into the project space that has been manufactured, refurbished or refinished within one year prior to occupancy must meet the emissions requirements.

Systems furniture is defined as either panel-based workstation compromised of modular interconnecting panels, hang-on components and drawer/filing components or a free standing grouping of furniture items and components that have been designed to work in concert. Seating is defined as task and guest chairs used with systems furniture.

Option 5 – Furniture and Furnishings

REQUIREMENTS:

Classroom furniture including all student desks and teacher desks, tables, and seats introduced into the project space that has been manufactured, refurbished or refinished within one year prior to occupancy must meet the emissions requirements.

Option E - Furniture

REQUIREMENTS:

Furniture is defined as any retail display fixtures, such as shelving, tables, storage units, chairs desks or cabinets required for use in the retail project and is purchased as a free standing or modular unit, regardless of where assembly takes place. Please note that built-in case work and built-in millwork items are to be considered part of the base building. Any systems, furniture and seating introduced into the project space that has been manufactured, refurbished and refinished within one year prior to occupancy must meet the emissions requirements.
